Our training model operates on a five-day schedule. On Day One, our team will collaborate with the agency’s management to identify areas that require additional focus regarding the topics addressed. Subsequently, we will conduct two consecutive 16-hour training sessions over the following four days. INVESTIGATIONS COURSES

CRIME SCENE FOUNDATIONS Training Program (SCFtp): 2 days. (Based on the request, this course can be extended to 4 or 5 days.)

An area critical in investigations is providing a detailed record of the crime scene, as there may only be one chance to get all the information from the scene. For many in small agencies, their only experience in this area may be what they learned in their basic police training or on-the-job training. The Lone Guardian LLC instructors will build on the officers' knowledge by conducting a crime scene investigation and highlighting the details within a crime scene that could make or break their case.

Participants in this course will receive a small, portable fingerprinting kit that can be easily carried in a bag or patrol unit.

INVESTIGATIONS FOUNDATIONS Training Program (IFtp): 2 days (Based on the request, this course can be extended to 4 or 5 days.)

Within small agencies, personnel often wear multiple hats, including those of investigators. However, they usually receive only basic law enforcement training or on-the-job training, despite investigations in criminal matters playing a significant role in the community's trust in law enforcement. This two-day training will expand officers' knowledge and improve their investigative skills. Sometimes, it is the small things that can make or break a case.

SMALL AGENCY EVIDENCE ROOM Training Program (SAERtp): 2 days. (Consult services can be added to assist agencies with their evidence rooms.)

An area that can be weak for small agencies is their property rooms. Sometimes, this could be as simple as a filing cabinet or closet. When it comes to unsolved cases, the preservation and storage of evidence becomes crucial. In most cases, it is an on-the-job learning experience for personnel. The Lone Guardian LLC instructors will build on the officers' knowledge by improving their evidence rooms within their budgets and highlighting the little things within an evidence room that could make or break their case.

SMALL AGENCY COURT Training Program (SACtp): 1 day.

What happens after the crime scene and investigation are done? It is now time for the case to head to trial. In small agencies, there might not be someone to help prepare a person for court. More so in 'smaller cases.' However, these small cases can make or break an officer's confidence. Within this course, Lone Guardian LLC's instructors will review how to prepare, the questions to ask, and what not to do in court.

SEARCH AND RESCUE COURSES (Limited class sizes of 12)

BASIC MANTRACKING TRAINING (BTMT): 2 days. (Based on the request, this course can be extended to 4 or 5 days.)

This introductory mantracking course teaches foundational tracking principles and their practical application. The course is designed for individuals with no prior experience in tracking and is intended to develop confidence in tracking another person.

SEARCH AND RESCUE COURSES (Limited class sizes of 6)

FOUNDATIONAL SEARCHING Training Program (FStp): 2 days. (Based on the request, this course can be extended to 4 or 5 days.)

Visual intelligence is crucial for criminal justice personnel as it involves searching for suspects, evidence, and lost individuals. Sometimes, this can be accomplished with one person, but it can also be effective with more people. Small agencies' front-line law enforcement personnel need to be able to organize people to complete searches and avoid damaging a potential crime scene.

- Direction of travel tracking

Participants receive a foundational search kit that includes a backpack equipped with a water source, evidence-processing tools, a GPS, and a spotting scope. This ensures they have practical gear for a search that may take them far from their vehicles.

This course can be custom-built to meet the needs of those wishing to attend. Class sizes can be increased if the focus is to establish a local search and rescue team comprised of community members. Contact us for more details.

SEARCH AND RESCUE COURSES (Limited class sizes of 12)

DRONE Training Program (Dtp): 2 days. (Based on the request, this course can be extended to 4 or 5 days.)

Requirements:

- Current FAA UAS pilot license (If not licensed, per FAA rule, those without a license would require a licensed pilot to supervise them; the agency would need to provide a licensed pilot for supervision.)
- Drone

Drones are becoming increasingly important in search and rescue operations. They can cover large distances swiftly and offer unique perspectives for locating individuals. They are invaluable in confined areas or challenging terrain, making drones a valuable resource for small departments. They can efficiently search areas without putting personnel at risk of injury.
